SUVHOA Facilities

All HOA facilities are located at 7290 Davenport Road. Members are welcome to use our clubhouse, pool, tennis court, ½ basketball court and playground. Your key card will open the gates for both the pool area and tennis courts.

Please honor these SUVHOA agreements:

- > Children under 15 must be accompanied by an adult
- > Guests must be accompanied by a member with a limit of 4 guests per member
- > The gates must remain closed and locked at all times
- > Trash and recycling trash cans are conveniently located around the pool deck – please use them to keep our shared spaces clean, safe and attractive
- > No bikes, skateboards, roller skates or scooters inside the gates. Park bikes in the bike racks
- > No pets, smoking, alcohol or foul language
- > Be respectful of our neighbors and keep noise at moderate levels

Pool

The pool is open to members from 6:00 am to 10:00 pm.

- > The pool is heated during the warm months (typically May through September) and during public school spring break
- > No lifeguard is on duty
- > The shallow pool is for use by children under the age of 5 and parent or guardian must be present. Swim diapers are required



Tennis Courts

Tennis courts are open year-round from sunrise to sundown.

- > Tennis shoes only on the court
- > Players with reservations take precedence over walk-ins
- > If someone is waiting to use the court, limit game time to 1 hour

> No tape allowed to be used on the tennis court

Playground

Our playground is open throughout the year.

Clubhouse Rental

Members are welcome to rent the clubhouse for private events year-round!

- > Rental fee is \$50 with a \$500 refundable deposit
- > Rental includes exclusive access to the clubhouse only, other members are welcome to use the pool and other facilities during your event
- > Alcohol and smoking are not permitted
